YOUR PRECIOUS DONATIONS TO CANCER CARE ARE TAX DEDUCTIBLE

The majority of your donations fund the operation and maintenance of Our House by providing a home-away-from-home for out-of-town cancer patients undergoing treatment in Wenatchee. This year due to the pandemic, there continues to be an increased need to provide hotel lodging assistance as Our House remains open only in a reduced capacity.

Through our Social Services Assistance Program, funds are available for those guests who are in need of financial assistance or other related expenses such as:

- *Treatment related travel (gas cards, bus passes) and lodging
- *Qualifying medical expenses or supplies
- *Prescriptions or co-pays

*Personal expenses may be

considered on an individual basis

One-time Grant applications are available when expenses exceed \$200. Grants are considered subject to review and approval by the Social Services Committee. When I was asked to interview Emily Scovill about her new position as Outreach/Communications Coordinator at Cancer Care, I had prepared questions to ask as I usually do. However, in walked Emily with a well-written document detailing what she does, plans to do and has already done for Our House. Rather than my asking her questions, she proceeded to explain all of the bullet points in her document. We have certainly acquired a gem in this young woman. She is the youngest daughter of our current Board President, Norma Scovill. She grew up in North Central Washington, has an AA from Wenatchee Valley College, a BA in Communications from Central Washington, and considers herself a "Jill of all trades" regarding technology and media. She is unafraid of new tech and loves to tinker around until she figures things out. Emily has been instrumental in the writing and implementation of a Nonprofit Reemergence Grant from the Community Foundation, a grant from Confluence Health and the acquisition of monies from the East Wenatchee American Rescue Plan funds. These funds have helped us to upgrade Becky's computer and router, buy office furniture, a new phone system, improve our website, add a Ring camera system to improve safety at the House's back entry and fund her position. She is also working on our social media presence, providing training to staff on various platforms, and updating all of our documents and forms. She is bringing us into the future in technology and marketing. We are off and running with Emily in the lead!
